COMMON QUESTIONS

Can students start an instrument in middle school?	YES
Are instruments available for low-income students?	YES
Can students start chorus in middle school?	YES
Can students be shared between ensembles?	NO
Can a chorus students audition for jazz band/select strings, and vice versa?	YES

MUSIC EXTRACURRICULARS

Chorale: auditions in September, rehearses Tuesdays afterschool year-round

Jazz Band: auditions in late-October, rehearses before school/during homeroom

Select Strings: auditions in October, rehearses Monday evenings at East HS/Fugett MS

Drama Club: produces a musical every March; cast requires auditions in December, all other crews don't require audition


