 - Students should be prepared to discuss the main points of each chapter and further Thomas C. Foster’s examples by exploring and analyzing literature - classic and modern-, songs, poems, films, and television, podcast, and other forms of literature.
 - Students will analyze their self-selected summer reading novels and the relationship to specific chapters of Thomas C. Foster’s *How to Read Literature Like a Professor revised edition*.
