#### **THE JOHN P. MCNULTY SCHOLARS PROGRAM**

**Amount Awarded:** 4-year full-tuition and partial-tuition scholarships awarded to St. Joseph's University students who are pursuing a degree in the natural sciences, mathematics or computer science.

**Deadline:** February 1, 2021

**Application Procedure:** Complete online application including essay, resume and letter of recommendation from a science or math teacher.

**Amount Awarded:** \$6,000 merit co-op scholarships renewable

**Deadline:** varies by school

**Application Procedures:** fill out application & write a 200 word essay describing why you have chosen to pursue a college cooperative education program;

**Description:** maintain 3.5 GPA; only 9 schools are participating in this; Drexel, Clarkson, University of Cincinnati, Johnson & Wales, Rochester Institute of Technology, & Merrimack College are just some of the participating schools.

#### **LAWRENCE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY**

**Amount Awarded:** up to \$4,000 a yr. for 4 years

**Deadline:** February 1, 2021
