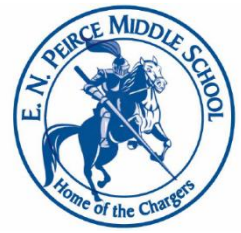

#### February 18<sup>th</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup> (U.A. Selection)

1. Login to PowerSchool
2. Verify Course Recommendations
3. Speak to Teachers if you have questions
4. Choose Elective Courses

#### March 2<sup>nd</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> (1<sup>st</sup> Course Change Window)

Verify classes. Submit a Course Request Form to change an elective, or override a teacher recommendation. Forms can be picked up in the office and on Peirce website.

#### March 16<sup>th</sup> - 23<sup>rd</sup> (2<sup>nd</sup> Course Change Window)

Double-check your recommendations and elective choices. Make sure changes are accurate. Submit a Course Request Form to the office if necessary.

#### March 24<sup>th</sup> (Final Deadline)

All changes **MUST** be made by this date!

#### 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> Course Selection

1. Review teacher recommendations
2. Choose a music class (Band, Chorus, Orchestra or Classroom Music)
3. If recommended for a WL, select either Spanish 1, French 1, or Reading.

#### 7<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Course Selection

1. Review teacher recommendations
2. If recommended for a World Language, choose a WL or Reading
3. Choose 2 courses from Arts & Humanities (+1 Alternate)
4. Choose 2 courses from Technology (+ 1 Alternate)
5. Choose **EITHER** a performing music (band, orchestra, or chorus) **OR** “Tech Ed Courses” options

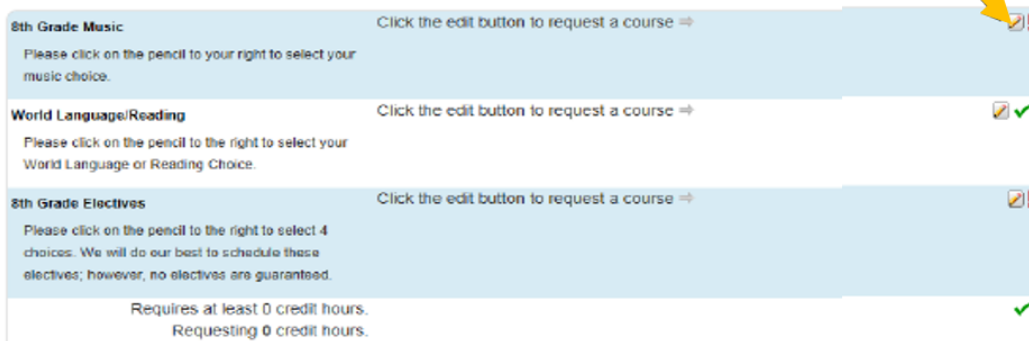
