## GRADE 5

Note: The following is a *recommended* list to help support your child in their learning. Feel free to personalize this list to your child and their learning preferences.

**Standard Supplies - These are the supplies that students will likely use on a frequent basis.**

- Pencils
- Erasers
- Post-Its
- 2 Yellow Highlighters
- Small dry erase board
- Fine tip dry erase markers
- Headphones or earbuds

**Creative Supplies - These are supplies that students may not use daily but will be helpful in allowing them to stay creative beyond their device when working on assignments and projects.**

- Thin markers
- Colored Pencils
- Crayons
- Glue Sticks or Tape
- Age appropriate scissors
- Centimeter/Inch ruler
- Index cards
- Construction paper
- 1 cm graph paper

**Students have the opportunity to organize their subject materials in the way that is most convenient for them.**

Possible Option 1:

- 4 Notebooks (Math, Reading, Writing, Science/Social Studies)
- 4 "two pockets" folders

Possible Option 2:

- Binder with lined paper
