

WCASD Elementary Sample Cyber Schedule

2nd - 3rd Grade

Task	Sample Details This schedule is designed to give parents a suggested structure for the school day. Live (synchronous) instruction is noted in orange. The rest of this sample school day is flexible, (asynchronous) recorded instruction and work.
Morning Meeting	The Cyber teacher will complete an attendance check-in and explain the student learning plan for the day.
Reading Workshop	<p>Small Group Guided Reading: The Cyber teacher will lead a small group reading lesson from an instructional level text.</p> <p>Shared Reading: The Cyber teacher will read the mentor text “The Invisible Boy” by Trudy Ludwig while modeling how to make inferences in order to understand the story’s theme.</p> <p>Independent Reading and Reading Response: Students will read at their independent level from a choice book for 15 minutes. After completing an independent reading book, students will complete the Reading Response Organizer.</p>
Writing Workshop	Shared and Independent Writing: The Cyber teacher will model the steps to writing a closing paragraph within a friendly letter. Students will continue writing their letters and upload progress to Seesaw for teacher feedback.

Social Emotional Learning	Social Emotional Learning: Digital discussion with classmates and teacher about accepting differences using the Second Step curriculum.
Social Studies	Student Choice: Complete one social studies exploration activity from the student choice board .
Brain Break!	Brain Break with Go Noodle: Footloose!
Math Workshop	<p>Numbertalk: Which One Doesn’t Belong? Students will use their knowledge of money to find out which picture doesn’t belong and explain their thinking in a Schoology discussion post.</p> <p>Division Lesson: The teacher will review how to use fact families to divide. After, students will independently practice the skill with a Schoology “Quick Check.”</p> <p>Independent Practice & Student Choice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Freckle Review and Practice: Measuring Area • Math Fact Choice Board: Students will complete one fact practice activity.
Physical Education	Jump Rope: Students will practice jump rope skills. The Cyber gym teacher will review healthy food and heart smart choices.
