COVID-19 Update - February 29: The district continues to monitor and be in communication with the Chester County Department of Health regarding novel Coronavirus. As with any flu season, part of our regular cleaning in the months from November to March includes topical surface cleaning with ammonia based cleaner each night on areas such as desks and doorknobs. Parents should also encourage flu precautions with children such as washing hands regularly, and keeping children home when sick.
