Dear Parents and Families of Incoming Sixth Grade Students,

I hope this email finds everyone safe and doing well. We sent an email last week regarding some changes that we've made to our **Fugett Middle School Transition Camp Programs**. As we stated in that email, Transition Camp will still be held at Fugett on **July 30 and August 6**.

Transition camp provides an opportunity for incoming 6th grade students to meet their principals, some of their teachers, learn their way around the school, understand our rotating schedule, successfully open a locker, meet new friends, and take part in events designed to ease the transition between elementary school and **Fugett Middle School**. During each transition day, students will be participating in activities designed to make them feel comfortable with middle school and the way we operate.

Earlier this year, we sent out Transition Camp registration information through your Elementary Schools. Thank you to those who have already responded. However, we have made some changes to the Transition Camp schedule since the original registration form was sent out, **and we ask that you fill out a new Google registration form** (we will refund all money that was sent prior to this email☺).

We will be holding two sessions each day. The **first session** will run from **9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.** The **second session** will run from **12:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.** [Please click here to access the Google form to update your child's registration date and to select the session of your choice.](#) **Again, it is important that you fill out this Google form even if you previously registered.** Please register your child for one session only.

- Students will be placed in small groups of 15-20 and we'll follow all social distancing guidelines
- We will not serve lunch during the 2-hour programs
- Hand sanitizer will be available for students and staff
- We will safely stagger all groups as we transfer from one station to another

Please arrive no earlier than 8:45 a.m. for the morning session and 12:15 p.m. for the afternoon session. This will allow all of us to safely social distance to our first assigned station. We will have stations that include opening a locker, how to read a middle school schedule, what clubs and activities to join as a 6th grader and a tour of all the important points in the building.

We look forward to meeting your child at Fugett Middle School during transition camp.
