English Language Arts

Foundational Skills

- I can apply grade-level phonics and word analysis skills in decoding words.
- I can read grade-level high-frequency words.
- I can read on-level text orally with accuracy, appropriate rate, and expression.

Fiction

- I can retell a story with a beginning, middle and end and identify characters, setting, problem and solution.
- I can write a narrative story with the events in order and a good ending.

Nonfiction

- I can identify the topic and text features in nonfiction texts to locate key facts and information.
- I can ask and answer who, what, when, where, why and how questions to help my comprehension.

Conventions

- I produce, expand, and rearrange complete simple and compound sentences.
- I generalize learned spelling patterns when writing words.

Math

Numbers and Operations in Base 10

- I can use place value concepts to represent amounts of tens and ones and to compare three-digit numbers.
- I can use place value concepts to read, write, and skip count to 1000.
- I can use place value understanding and properties of operations to add and subtract within 1000.

Operations and Algebraic Thinking

- I can represent and solve problems involving addition and subtraction within 100.
- I can use mental strategies to add and subtract within 20.
- I can work with equal groups of objects to gain foundations for multiplication.
