8th Grade Dance Policy

1. The dance is only open to currently enrolled Peirce Middle School 8th grade students.
2. In order for everyone to have a safe and enjoyable time at the dance, a student will be declared ineligible for the dance if he/she:
 - Has 10 processed referrals during the year
 - Has any Level III offense one month prior to the dance
 - Has three processed referrals (Levels II or III) two weeks prior to the dance
 - Has been involved in a fight, smoking or a verbal assault one week prior to the dance
 - Has been placed on suspension (internal or external) the day before/of
 - Has consistently demonstrated behavior that is defiant or disrespectful towards authority or peers as determined by Peirce Administration
3. Students who attend the dance must abide by the rules and regulations of the West Chester Area School District's Discipline code.
4. The 8th Grade Dance is not a prom. It is a culminating activity. Limos are not permitted.
5. Boys' required attire: dress shirt, tie, and slacks (no jeans).
6. Girls' required attire: dress-up dresses that are appropriate for a school function. No low cut dresses or mini skirts are permitted.
7. There will be an 8th Grade Assembly held by the building's administrators one month prior to the dance. The purpose will be to address behavior and expectations.
8. In order to purchase a ticket, the 8th Grade Dance Letter must be signed by a parent and returned by the due date.
