




Middle School Philosophy

Team Structure

- student progress
- interdisciplinary planning
- parent communication





Technology

Each student **receives a laptop and orientation** on use and care.

Teachers post course materials and assignments on **Schoology** (Learning Management System)

 Students are expected to bring their charged laptop with them to school each day
